The Religious Education Office is working with *My Catholic Faith Delivered* which offers the same textbooks we use for the in-person classes, but in an online format with lessons and a high-tech dashboard where grades and lessons can be managed. These online lessons are asynchronous which means they can be done anytime. Along with these classes, there will be online live video classes with a catechist.

Confirmation

First Holy Communion

To receive the Sacrament of First Holy Communion in 2nd grade, children must receive two full years of Catholic education in 1st and 2nd grade.
