- Over the last seven years, we have assisted numerous neighbors in six zip codes in Annandale, Springfield and Burke.
- In FY24 provided entrance fees and weekly rent for 38 individuals dealing with addiction so that they could enter or remain in one of ten Oxford House sober living residences in our service area.
- In FY24 in collaboration with other St. Vincent de Paul Conferences and other organizations, helped 120 families to pay rent in arrears to avoid eviction and 78 families to pay delinquent utility bills to avoid disconnection.
- In FY24 provided 735 \$50 prepaid grocery cards for 288 households, as well as baby supplies and diapers to families who call on us for help.
- Assisted with medical and dental bills that have allowed those we serve to receive necessary care.
- Paid for tools, work clothing, auto repairs and tuition costs that made it possible for individuals to remain in the workforce.
- Christmas Project 2024: Provided wrapped gifts for 95 children in 31 families and assisted these families with grocery cards. With the help of the Knights of Columbus and the Catholic Charities Coat Drive, also provided turkeys, warm coats, hand-made hats, and other articles of clothing to some families.
- We work with other SSVdP Conferences and parishes, Catholic Charities, Fairfax County Coordinated Services Planning (CSP), Food for Others, local food pantries, ECHO, and other community-based organizations to create assistance packages for those with greater or complex needs.
