

7th GRADE SAINT REPORT FOR CONFIRMATION

The purpose of this report is for you to become familiar with your Confirmation namesake. You may select a new name or reaffirm your baptismal name. The name you choose can be either masculine or feminine.

Choose the name of a saint who interests you, and begin to research his/her life. There are many reference books available in the Religious Education office for your use. Internet search engines will also provide reference material.

Some useful guidelines when writing the report:

- What is it about this saint that interests you?
- What are some of the characteristics of this saint that you admire and hope to imitate?
- When and where did this saint live?
- What kind of challenges did this saint endure during his/her life?
- How did this saint love God above all else?
- How did this saint show his/her love for others?
- When is this saint's feast day?
- Summarize the life of this saint.

Please Note:

- **The saint report is due on SUN APR 7, MON APR 8, WED APR 10**
- The report should be two typewritten, double-spaced pages with 1" margins and 12 pt. font (at least two pages and practically at most two pages).
- Write the report in your own words, using the ideas from your research. If you quote part of a text, use quotation marks and list the source at the end of your report.
- Include the saint's full name or title, since many have identical first names (i.e. Saint John the Evangelist, Saint John the Baptist, Saint John Vianney).
- Include your full name at the top of the report.

The saint you have chosen for your Confirmation namesake can be a friend for life. Do not hesitate to pray to him/her for assistance at any time.
